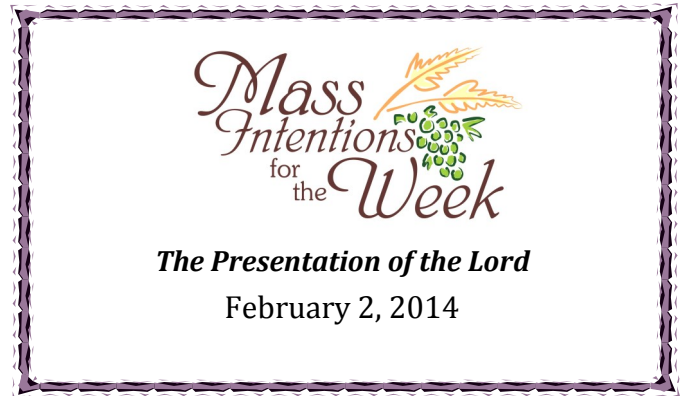

Dear Parishioners:

What a terrific celebration of Catholic Schools Weeks we had at OLM. Fr. Connors set a great tone for this annual event with his excellent homily about the importance of Catholic Education. The Open House at our school was visited by many families considering Catholic Education. Also, some alumni returned for a visit to their old school. We ended the week with a joyful celebration of Mass on the Feast of St. John Bosco, the Patron of Catholic Youth. I ask you to please continue to pray for the administration, faculty, students and families of Our Lady of Mercy School.

This past week was also National School Choice Week and was marked by a gathering at the RI Statehouse on Thursday. Some may ask, what is school choice? School choice gives parents the freedom to choose their children's education, while encouraging healthy competition among schools to better serve families' needs. School choice lets parents use the public funds set aside for their children's education to choose the schools—public or private, near or far, religious or secular—that work best for them.

There are many types of school choice programs including vouchers, education savings accounts, tax-credit scholarships, and individual tax credits offered in many states. All of these various programs have been declared constitutional and provide an opportunity for

many low-income families to make a choice of which school their child attends.

Every year many Rhode Island children are unable to pursue academic success through school choice because their families cannot afford to pay the full cost of tuition. There is a program called the Rhode Island Scholarship Tax Credit that allows corporations and small businesses to help lower-income families afford private school education for their kids in return for a substantial tax credit.

These businesses are all allowed to receive up to a 90% tax credit amounting to \$100,000 annually on contributions to a scholarship granting organization. Last year the General Assembly increased the cap on the total tax credit to \$1.5 million. Many businesses take advantage of this opportunity to both help financially struggling students and gain a significant tax credit.

The Diocese of Providence established a scholarship granting organization called Financial Aid for Children's Education of Rhode Island (FACE). FACE provides financial aid for needy students wishing to attend a RI Catholic School of their choice. Every dollar received through FACE is directed to low-income families in need of tuition assistance and children searching for the school of their choice. If you work for a corporation of any size or own a small business you might consider looking into this great program. More information is available through the Catholic School Office

Also, at the RI Statehouse last week the Annual RI Right to Life "*Rally for Life*" was held. This event saw a large crowd including many pro-life elected officials standing together in support of the defense of human life. It was a great witness to the call to respect all human life.

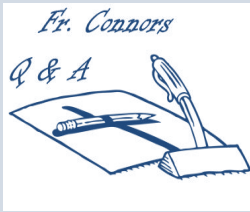
There are some challenges facing the state and the defense of human life. One is Health-Source RI, the local Obamacare Exchange created by Governor Chafee. This program includes coverage for abortion-on-demand in every healthcare exchange plan. Also, there is a drive by some legislators to expand Medicaid coverage to include the public funding of abortion.

It is clear there is much work to be done in the RI General Assembly in defense of human life. Please pray that our elected officials might be able to see the immeasurable dignity of all human beings, most especially the innocent unborn, and have the conviction and courage to protect human life in law.

I invite you to join us on Monday night as Fr. James Ruggeri from St. Patrick's Church in Providence offers us a talk entitled "*Blessed Are the Poor.*" He is a outstanding priest and preacher and I know you will enjoy his time with us. Hope to see you on Monday. Have a great week. God Bless.

**Dear Fr. Connors: What was the Second Vatican Council?**



I was surprised to hear this question this week. Since the Second Vatican Council took place some fifty years ago, many today are less familiar with what took place. The Second Vatican Council or "Vatican II" refers to the twenty-first ecumenical council of the Church. It took place from 1962-1965 in Rome and published sixteen documents.

The Second Vatican Council was called by Pope John XXIII who will be canonized a Saint this April. After his death the Council was presided over by Pope Paul VI. Both Pope John Paul II and Pope Benedict XVI said it was their principal purpose to implement the teaching of the Second Vatican Council.

Vatican II stands in continuity with the twenty councils which preceded it. Right in the *Acts of the Apostles* we hear of the apostles—the first bishops of the Church— meeting to decide whether new Christians needed to follow Jewish law. This was, in a way, the first Council or proto-council called to clarify doctrine and pastoral practice. The Council of Nicea in the fourth century composed the basic structure of the Nicene Creed which we say at Mass each Sunday.

The Second Vatican Council was not called so much to refute doctrinal errors as to put the Church on firmer footing to evangelize the contemporary world. The Council can be understood as a continuation of the First Vatican Council called in the late nineteenth century. Vatican I defined the role of the Pope. Vatican II gave elaborate doctrinal expression to the role of bishops. Vatican II also called for a deeper appreciation of the Sacred Liturgy as the foundation of the spiritual life. Active participation in the liturgy—that is, praying the liturgical texts— was called for as the basis of all Catholic spirituality.

As now fifty years have passed since the calling of the Second Vatican Council the task remains to understand and reflect upon its documents. The writings of recent popes provide the authentic interpretation.

**A Note About Parking at  
Our Lady of Mercy Church**



We have received regular and reoccurring complaints from our OLM neighbors about those parishioners and/or guests to our parish who park on the side streets surrounding the Church building. Some of these streets are ONE SIDE ONLY parking and very often the NO PARKING signs are ignored by parishioners and/or guests on their way to Mass. In fact, neighbors have reported that some people on the way to Mass not only ignored their

request not to park in the No Parking Zone but a few parishioners and/or guests have responded with choice words in response to the neighborly request. This happened on the way into Holy Mass!!!! It is an embarrassment for the entire parish that people associated with OLM would treat our neighbors with such disrespect and lack of Christian charity. Some OLM neighbors also complain that their driveways are regularly blocked during the hours of Mass on Sunday and during major celebrations like Christmas, Easter, Confirmation and First Communion. Others report people parking on their lawns. I ask you all to please use the parking lots next to and behind our school to avoid this problem. If you must park on a side street, please respect the law and our neighbors and their property. Please do not park on lawns or block driveways. **Thank You for your attention to this matter.**

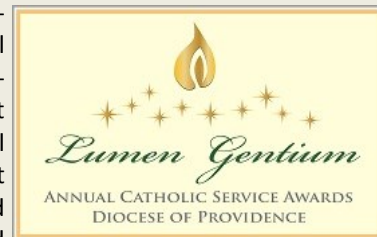
# Prayer Chain

### **Lumen Gentium Annual Catholic Service Award**

Following the great success last year of the Diocese of Providence's first ever presentation of the *Lumen Gentium* Awards, which formally recognized individuals and groups "who toil in the vineyard" were honored for their service and devotion to the church, the diocese has opened the nominations process to select candidates for the award once again. **This year the event is to be held May 14, 2014 at Twin River Event Center** in Lincoln, will be used to support the food pantries, meal sites and parish sharing programs of the 75 parishes that are involved in nutritional programs. Proceeds from last year's dinner, which raised \$50,000 were used to fund



operations at Emmanuel House, allowing for the diocesan men's homeless shelter to remain open through the summer months. The *Lumen Gentium* Awards recognize those who have provided outstanding service to their parish, the diocese and/or the local community at-large. A committee, under the leadership Msgr. Albert A. Kenney, diocesan Vicar General/Moderator of the Curia, welcomes nominees through an online process on the Diocese of Providence Web site at [www.dioceseofprovidence.org/lumen-gentium-2014](http://www.dioceseofprovidence.org/lumen-gentium-2014). **Nominations, which must be received by Friday, February 14,** will be reviewed by the committee, with final recommendations submitted to Bishop Thomas J. Tobin for his approval. The *Lumen Gentium* Awards, are presented in 10 categories: Parish Service, Community Service and Charitable Outreach, Catholic Education, Evangelization, Communications, Administration and Stewardship, Respect Life, Public Service, Distinguished Catholic Youth and Friend of the Diocese. Groups, organizations and individuals — laity, clergy and religious — are eligible to be nominated. While it Proceeds from a dinner to honors this year's award recipients, to is expected that nominees will come from within the Catholic community, other nominees will also be considered, provided that they and their work are consistent with the teachings and mission of the Catholic Church.
