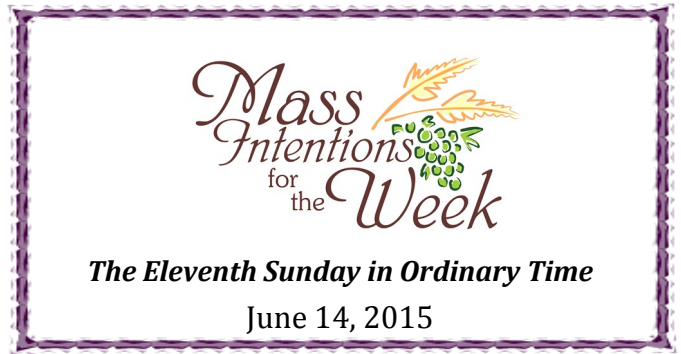

Dear Eric: What does it mean to experience a call from God?

First and foremost, everyone's primary calling in life is to be in union with God. The *Catechism of the Catholic Church* states that: "All are

called to holiness: "Be perfect, as your heavenly Father is perfect (CCC 2013)." We are meant to be with God because we are made for eternal life with Him.

But while we're living our day to day lives; how are we to know if we are in our true God-given vocation? Traditionally the church teaches that there are a number of vocations to which one can be called: priesthood or religious life, marriage, and single life. All three are meant to be lived out in service to God and His Church.

Most people will be called to marriage as the family is the bedrock of the church. This is why it is so important for parents to be active participants in the faith. The parents are the first teachers to their children and are charged with handing on the faith to them.

Some are called to priesthood or religious life where they are literally laying down their lives in service to God and His Church. And others are called simply to live as single lay people in service to God.

Each individual person is created for the vocation that God has picked for them. This means that true happiness can only be found and fully lived out in that vocation. Each person has been created with special gifts for their own vocation. However, because of free will, each person has the ability to freely choose their path in life.

As someone who has reason to believe that he is being called to the priesthood, experiencing the vocational call results in a strong sense of peace and joy. I experience true happiness everyday even when I may not be having the best of days. Also, your calling is often affirmed by other people. Many people in my life asked if I ever considered the priesthood and told me that they thought I'd make a good priest. The thing to remember is never to embark upon discernment alone; in my journey, so far, I've had a lot of spiritual guidance.

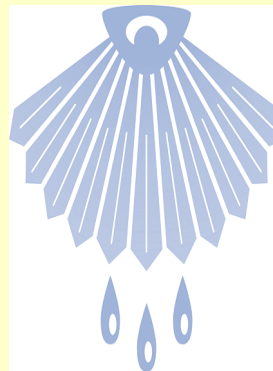
