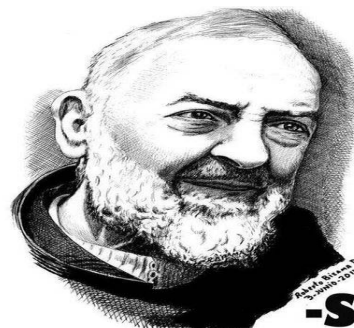

Dear Fr. Connors: I read in the news that the Church has made it easier to get an annulment now? Is that true?

An annulment, or a declaration of nullity, is a judgment of the Church, that what appeared to be a valid marriage was not in fact a valid marriage from the beginning. Some element necessary for a marriage, free consent, the intention of permanence, an openness to have children, etc. was not present at the time of the celebration of the marriage.

Last week Pope Francis issued new guidelines for how the process for declaring nullity would take place. Strictly speaking it is not going to be easier for nullity to be granted as much as the process should be quicker and more efficient.

A declaration of nullity is still a question of truth: did God really join these two people together? An annulment is not something one simply obtains. It is a question of the truth of the matter: were these two people ever actually validly married? If they were in fact married only death ends that bond.

The new procedures announced last week simplify the process for declaring nullity. For example, instead of two separate diocesan Tribunals agreeing on a declaration of nullity the judgment of one court is sufficient. Also, those cases that are especially obvious, for example, those contracting marriage simply to gain immigration status, can move through a simpler process entrusted directly to bishops.

As the Pope has pointed out this is not so much to make more annulments be granted as much as to make the process more efficient. The Pope has said many times people deserve an answer. They cannot have their lives on hold.

The new procedures for examining the possible nullity of marriages should lead to a more efficient judgment, not necessarily more judgments in favor of nullity. All of this is intended to be faithful to the Lord's words who speaks so strongly about the value of marriage.
